



## BIKE TRANSPORT INDEMNITY FORM

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For the purposes of this document the following words shall have the associated meaning:

- ‘the Event Organisers’ shall mean and include the following parties: Children in the Wilderness Mkambati, Nedbank Limited, Wilderness Holdings Limited and subsidiaries, South African National Parks, The Northern Tuli Game Reserve, Zimbabwe Parks and Wildlife Management Agency, Wildlife and Environmental Society of Zimbabwe, Sentinel Limpopo Safaris, Shashe Wilderness Camp, Venetia Reserve and Nottingham Estate as well as all affiliates, employees, directors, agents, shareholders, officials, concessionaires, contractors and representatives of any form of the foregoing entities.
- The “Event” shall mean and include the mountain bike Tour, which is to take place from Tuesday 23 July 2019 to Sunday 28 July 2019 in the Northern Tuli Game Reserve, the Tuli Safari Area, the Maramani Community Area, The Wards of Shashe, Maramani and Limpopo, Sentinel Ranch, Nottingham Estate and the Mapungubwe National Park (“event areas”), all related activities including but not limited to riding, being conveyed both to and from the Tour, accommodation, meals, opening and closing ceremonies and any other function or activity related, whether directly or indirectly to the mountain bike Tour.

I, the undersigned \_\_\_\_\_ agree that:

1. Transport for a bicycle to and/or from the event is an additional service taken up and booked at one’s own discretion and entirely at own risk.
2. I voluntarily elect to use the bike transport service offered by the Event Organisers for the transport of my bicycle between Johannesburg and Mapungubwe National Park, where the Event shall commence and end. I would like to utilize the service on the following routes (please tick one):
  - One way from Johannesburg to Mapungubwe National park
  - One way from Mapungubwe National Park to Johannesburg
  - Return from Johannesburg to Mapungubwe National Park and back to Johannesburg
3. The service is booked and paid for by the above-mentioned individual, unless otherwise agreed.



4. The above-mentioned individual should adhere to the bike drop off and collection dates and times as specified below:

5. Should the bike not be dropped off on the above-mentioned dates and times, alternative arrangements must be made in writing to, and confirmed by the Event Organisers.
6. The bicycle loading and offloading will be managed by a selected and supervised team, onto specialized bike trailers.
7. The trailer(s) will be towed to and from the event by use of main roads, highways and dirt roads (where necessary).
8. I am acquainted, aware of and appreciate the risks that are associated with selecting the optional transport service.
9. The Event Organisers cannot be held accountable for the loss or damage to a bicycle whilst being transported to and/or from the event.
10. It is essential that the above-mentioned individual should take out personal insurance for the bicycle that is being transported.
11. It is the responsibility of the above-mentioned individual that the bicycle and related parts are included in their insurance for the duration of the event, transportation and storage.
