



2020 PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

MINIMUM ENTRY DONATION

There is a minimum entry donation payable per participant (amount outlined below) in order to participate in this event which includes accommodation for the 4 nights, all meals, a registration pack (which includes an array of goodies that you may find useful during the Tour) as well as a daily 20 minute massage per riding day.

Book and pay in full by the 28 February 2020: R20 000 pp

Book and pay in full from the 01 March 2020: R23 000

Group special: book 12 spaces, only pay for 11.

Limited space available. No invitation needed.

PAYMENT TERMS

Credit Card

- If you have selected the payment by credit card, the full amount of Amounts TBC (respective to the date of booking) is due immediately and made as one payment on your registration profile.

EFT

- If you have selected to pay by EFT (bank transfer), the Minimum Entry Donation is payable within 10 days after registration in order to secure your entry. Amount due is according to the date of payment and not the date of registration.
- Proof of payment must be emailed to info@childreninthewilderness.com.

Voucher

- You can only select to pay by voucher if your admin/team captain has been in touch with you and sent you a voucher number.

MINIMUM ENTRY DONATION INCLUDES

- Tented accommodation – single occupancy in two man tents;
- 20 minute massage per riding day;
- Support vehicle assistance;
- Refreshment stops during the course of the day;
- Water and energy supplement in camp and at the tea and brunch stops;
- All meals from lunch on registration day to breakfast on the last day;
- Services of camp staff;
- Services of bicycle technicians (spares are for the participants own account);
- Medical support;
- Photographs and video footage of the event;
- National Park entry fees and traversing fees.



MINIMUM ENTRY DONATION EXCLUDES

- Visa fees (if applicable);
- Beverages supplied from the bar;
- Bike rental (if applicable);
- Cycling clothes, equipment and spares (we will communicate whether we receive any clothing sponsorship);
- Travel costs to the start of the event and back home again;
- Tips/gratuities for local staff;
- Bicycle insurance (please note Event Organisers cannot take responsibility for lost or damaged bicycles please ensure that you have adequate insurance to cover this risk);
- Cancellation Fees WE RECOMMEND THAT ALL PARTICIPANTS TAKE OUT TRAVEL CANCELLATION INSURANCE SO THAT YOU ARE COVERED SHOULD YOU NEED TO CANCEL.

CANCELLATION TERMS

In the event of a cancellation, the following cancellation terms will apply:

- No refunds will be processed after the 30 April 2020. Please ensure that you have cancellation insurance to cover you should you need to cancel.
- From 01 May 2020 onwards - you will be liable for 100% of your Minimum Entry Donation.
- Should you need to cancel due to a medical reason, please contact the Event Organisers.

Due to the logistics of this event with the cross border formalities, we cannot be lenient about our Terms and Conditions. A cancellation within 12 weeks means that we forfeit the ability to fill your spot. Secondly within this time frame we have already ordered and paid for many of the supplies and therefore there are costs involved which the charity would then have to carry. For this reason we do recommend that all participants look at taking some form of travel cancellation insurance policy for this purpose.

SUBSTITUTION TERMS

- In a situation where the participant cannot ride and has paid in full he/she may transfer their entry to another rider with notification to the Event Organisers.
- Substitution is only possible up until 1 week before the event (13 July 2020), thereafter, your entry will be forfeited.
- It is the participants responsibility to find a replacement if they can no longer participate in the Tour.
- Once substitution is confirmed with the Event Organizers the new rider MUST get their passport copy to the Organizers, as well as register online, by COB that day.

ADDITIONAL DONATIONS

- As always, we encourage riders to raise as much sponsorship as possible. Any additional funds raised go directly to the Children in the Wilderness programme (further information on this non-profit initiative can be found on www.childreninthewilderness.com.)
