



PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

MINIMUM ENTRY DONATION:

There is a minimum entry donation payable per rider to participate in this event which includes accommodation for the five nights, all meals (five meals a day), a gift pack (which includes an array of goodies that you may find useful during the Tour), soft drinks, water and energy supplement along the route as well as a daily 20-minute massage per riding day.

- R23 000 per rider
- Group special: book 12 spaces, only pay for 11 riders

PAYMENT TERMS:

- Full payment is required by the end of February 2021.
- If you register post 28th February 2021, full payment will be required within 10 days of registration.

PAYMENT METHODS:

Credit Card:

If you have selected the payment by credit card, the full amount is due immediately and made as one payment on your registration profile. When paying by credit card, the full amount is due immediately and needs to be made in Step 4 of the registration process. Once paid, you will move onto the final step in the registration process where you will submit your registration. You will receive a confirmation email.

EFT:

- If you have selected to pay by EFT, the minimum entry donation is payable within 10 days after registration to secure your entry. Please use your full name as the reference.
- Proof of payment must be emailed to info@childreninthewilderness.com

Voucher:

- If one person or company is paying for multiple entries, you will need to register using a voucher.
- The Admin/Team Captain will need to email the request to the event organisers with the number of riders (including a list of names) they want to pay for, and a voucher will be generated for this specific group.
- The Admin/Team Captain will then distribute the voucher number to all his/her team members and this number will need to be captured in the payment section of each individuals online registration so the profiles of the team can be linked.

MINIMUM ENTRY DONATION INCLUDES:

- Tented accommodation – single occupancy in two man tents with a high density foam mattress;
- 20 minute massage per riding day;
- Medical support, support vehicle assistance and services of camp staff;
- Refreshment stops during the course of the day;
- Water and energy supplement in camp and along the riding route;
- All meals from lunch on registration day to breakfast on the last day (five meals per riding day will be provided);
- Services of bicycle technicians (spares are for the participants own account);
- Photographs and video footage of the event;
- National Park entry fees and traversing fees.

MINIMUM ENTRY DONATION EXCLUDES:

- Visa fees (if applicable);
- Beverages supplied from the bar;
- Bike rental (if applicable);
- Cycling clothes, equipment and spares (we will communicate whether we receive any clothing sponsorship);
- Travel costs to the start of the event and back home again;
- Tips/gratuities for local staff;
- Bicycle insurance (please note Event Organisers cannot take responsibility for lost or damaged bicycles please ensure that you have adequate insurance to cover this risk);
- Cancellation Fees **WE RECOMMEND THAT PARTICIPANTS TAKE OUT TRAVEL CANCELLATION INSURANCE AS WELL AS EVENT CANCELLATION INSURANCE**

CANCELLATION TERMS:

In the event of a cancellation, the following cancellation terms will apply:

- No refunds will be processed after the 30 April 2021. Please ensure that you have cancellation insurance to cover you should you need to cancel.
- From 01 May 2021 onwards - you will be liable for 100% of your minimum entry donation.
- Should you need to cancel due to a medical reason, please contact the Event Organisers.

Due to the logistics of this event with the cross border formalities, we cannot be lenient about our cancellation terms. A cancellation within twelve weeks means that we forfeit the ability to fill your spot. By this time, we have already ordered and paid for many of the supplies and therefore there are costs involved which the charity would then have to carry. For this reason we recommend that participants take out travel cancellation insurance.

SUBSTITUTION TERMS:

- In a situation where the participant cannot ride and has paid in full he/she may transfer their entry to another rider with notification to the Event Organisers.
- Substitution is only possible up until the end of June, thereafter, your entry will be forfeited.
- It is the participants responsibility to find a replacement if they can no longer participate in the Tour.
- Once substitution is confirmed with the Event Organizers the new rider **MUST** get their passport copy to the Organizers, as well as register online, by close of business that day.



ADDITIONAL CASH DONATIONS:
